Indictments having been found against the participants in the horrible massacre at Mountain Meadows, the question now is, what is being done to bring the offenders to justice? The prosecution cannot recede, nor can the United States Marshal shirk his duty on the plea of lack of funds. It is the duty of the prosecution to furnish the Marshal the names of the witnesses required, and request that they be immediately subpoenaed; this done, the Marshal cannot have any excuse for failing to subpoenae. It will not do for the Government to make any mistakes in this important case, in which Brigham Young is the head and front, and John D. Lee and others the instruments through which this wholesale murder was perpetrated.
